CALCUTTA, 7.—The strike of Calcutta rickshaw pullers entered its eighth day today. Nearly 6,000 rickshaws and 25,000 pullers are involved.

The representatives of owners and pullers met the Additional Labour Commissioner for Bengal yesterday when efforts for a settlement were continued. —ADI

**BIJAPUR, 7.**—More than 7,000 'hamals' in the Bijapur bazar went on strike on Wednesday, demanding increase in their wages. They organized a procession and a protest meeting. Carts loaded with commodities from surrounding villages are standing in the bazar awaiting unloading. Negotiations for settlement of the dispute are still in progress.—APL

KARACHI, 8.—The official estimate of the loss of life in the Karachi coastal area due to the tidal wave on November 28, was given by the Chief Secretary to the Sind Government today. He said that according to their preliminary computation, 250 people lost their lives; but "quite a number of persons" lost their homes though he was not in a position to give the exact figures.

The Chief Secretary remarked: "They were heavily exaggerated. The coastline is sparsely populated. The sub-divisional officials have asked for only small grants for relief, indicating that the damage caused is not as heavy as reported."
