TIDAL WAVE FATALITIES IN BOMBAY SUBURBS

BOMBAY, Nov. 28.—An unexpected
tidal wave swept the seashore between
Juhu and Varsova, suburbs of Bombay
at about 8 o'clock on Wednesday morn-
ing, washing away four women and a
man—all fisherfolk.

The upheaval was so forceful at Danda,
two miles from Juhu, that several boats
broke away from their moorings.

According to a meteorologist, this tidal
wave was possibly due to the rocking of
the sea surface by one of the after-
shocks of Wednesday morning's earth-
quake.—A.P.I.
